Although known as La Bastarda, she was raised within the family of her renown father, the Governor General of *La Florida*, the Adelantado, the founder of St. Augustine and Protector of the Holy Catholic Church.

The Ormond Beach Historical Society will be providing free food, coffee, bottled water, and soda. A cash "donation" wine bar will also be available.
