This collection consists of 66 postcards dating from 1904 to the 1960's. They represent many areas of Ormond Beach to include: The Casements, Ellinor Village, Ormond Hotel and the Tomoka River reflecting the natural beauty of our waterways. Postcards were produced in mass and made widely available for the promotion of tourism, and are often the only record of a location or a building in an area. This can become a field of study as an area changes and the postcard leaves a trace of an earlier time.
