



Several of the couples we became friendly with were staying in these three-room villas. They are so well-planned that four people have plenty of room in them. They have a nice airy bedroom with twin beds, large walk-in clothes closet, tiled bath with tub and shower and a full-size sofa bed in the living room for an additional one or two persons. Just like the other villas we visited, the kitchens are fully equipped—really complete with cooking utensils, dishes and silverware.

THE "B"---THREE ROOM VILLA WITH SLEEPING PORCH

We noticed that the "B" Villas had more space, the rooms were larger and there was the added advantage of a screened sleeping porch. The kitchen is quite large and there is adequate dining space. Actually this villa is equally comfortable for from three to six persons, since the double size innerspring sofa beds in the living room and on the sleeping porch can be utilized in addition to the full-size bedroom with its twin beds.

THE "C" VILLA WITH GARAGE

We met several couples who were staying for the season in the "C" Villas. They were so comfortable with the added luxury of a garage, storage space and screened sleeping porch or breezeway. The large bedroom has twin beds and a large clothes closet, tiled bath with tub-shower combination, fully equipped kitchen and a spacious hall serving the kitchen, living room, bedroom and bath.

"B AND C" DELUXE VILLAS







THE "D" TYPE TWO BEDROOM VILLA

BEACH AREA Naturally our favorite recreation, enjoy the sun and surf without the beach is a lot of "stretch" room and the brightly colored




spot was the beach area—it was wonderful to be able to




SHOPPING CENTER


We are looking forward to spending many pleasant hours in the new guest lounge this year. A social director will help us plan bridge games and meet people.



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
